





PROJECT 4 QUOTABLE SITE OF CITABLE QUOTES 65 PTS**due WEEK 5 | Thu AUGUST 5**

For this project you will create a five-page site using HTML, CSS and Dreamweaver. Your site will be comprised of an index page and four “Quotation” pages - each of which will display a typographic design of a quotation. The index page will contain links to the four pages. The quotes, and your designs, must be of a common theme or author. [Click here to view examples](#)



- Find four quotations which appeal to you and have a common theme and/or author. Make sure you know to whom to attribute each of the quotes (i.e. who said them). You will present your quotes in class, and also turn-in a PDF file to Canvas before the start of class.

Due Week 4 | Tue July 27 | 5 pts

- Create a minimum of **five** distinctly different concept roughs for the project index page. Roughs should be hand-drawn on PLAIN WHITE PAPER in proportion to 1366 x 768 pixels. Specify whether you want your links to open in the same window, or in pop-up windows.

Presentation Create a five-page PDF. Each page should each include a photo/scan of one concept sketch, plus a one paragraph explanation of the idea, plus a description of how the navigation will work.

Due Week 4 | Wed July 28 | 10 pts

- Create computer-generated comps in Adobe Photoshop/Illustrator for:
 - Your project homepage (favorite design from Step 2). **Important** Be sure your Photoshop/Illustrator document size is **1366 x 768 pixels**.
 - A typical quote page.

Then create wireframes with pixel dimensions for placement of all key elements in your pages. Wireframes may be hand-drawn or computer-generated.

Presentation Turn-in zip-compressed file to Canvas that includes: 1) PSD or AI files; 2) PDF file; and 3) Wireframes.

Due Week 4 | Thu July 29 | 20 pts

- Using Adobe Photoshop or Illustrator, create art for all the elements on your project index, and each of your quote pages. Don't forget to include an attribute for each quote.
- Create your web images using Photoshop/Illustrator.
- Create and construct your pages in Dreamweaver.
- Update your site *home page* with a link to your *project 4* page. Create a link to your *homepage* from your *project 4* page.
- Upload/synchronize all new or modified files to your server.
