This is your final project. You will create a site of multiple pages showing the work you've accomplished this semester. The projects you'll be featuring are: 1 Self-Portrait project; 2 ABCs of CSS project; 3 GIF Animation assignment; 4 More Divs & Behaviors assignment; 5 Quotable Site project. Optional Include work from outside class.

- 1 : Your site should have an *index.html* page (you created this page for *Project 3 your.homepage*), plus at least one page for each of the above-listed projects.
- 2: You may use your index page from Project 3 exactly as is, modify it, or start completely over. Your pages must have a width of 1366 pixels. You will need instructor approval to deviate from this width.
- 3 : All your pages should be interconnected via hyperlinks. You should be able to navigate through your entire site, then easily return to any page. Ease of navigation is *very* important.
- 4 : All of your pages should also be connected by a visual style. The pages in your site should have a cohesive look even though they will display a variety of different projects. This can be accomplished through design, copywriting and navigation structure.
- 5: This project will be due at the beginning of the final. Your site *MUST* be uploaded to your web server, LIVE and ready to be viewed when the final begins Week 16 | May 15 | 9am class 11am | 4pm class 5pm

IMPORTANT | 1) You *must* attend the final (-10 points if you don't);
2) You are required to .zip compress your entire site folder and turn it in to Canvas by the start of the final (-10 points if you don't).

- 6: You will be judging the final projects yourselves during the final. You will determine which you think to be the best sites within the class, and rank them in order. Students who receive the most points from their peers will receive the best grades. There will be a predetermined number of A grades, B grades, etc. So, in essence, you will be competing for the best grades. More details will be supplied as to judging and grades in the class prior to the final.
- 7: Finally, there are no specific requirements for this project other than what is listed on this page, announced in class or via e-mail. But please remember the consequence of Point 6 above is that those who put the most effort into their site will most likely earn the best grades.
